**Company Replaced Floating Pipeline Warning Buoys with
Permanent Piling Markers, October, 2006
after notifying Claiborne Parish Watershed District Commission**

Ronald Day (318-245-6712), field representative for Federal/State Pipeline Safety Program (LA DNR Office of Conservation Pipeline Division, I believe) Natural Gas Pipelines and advised:

- 1) OK to place permanent markers in the hidden hazard area;
- 2) Placement location (“as close as practical” to the pipeline) and warning markers should conform to Regulation 192.707(a-d) [Natural Gas Pipeline Safety Regulations: 2909 Line Markers for Mains and Transmission Lines]
- 3) Marker Warnings should conform to 192,707(d) [enclosed].
